ADVICE TO APPLICANTS

This Referee Report form must be used in conjunction with applications for graduate research scholarships tenable at The University of Western Australia.

Applicants have the right to choose their own referees. However, in the case of Honours students or recent graduates of The University of Western Australia, it is recommended that:

- one referee should preferably be **the supervisor of the Honours programme** in which the applicant is/was enrolled, or the Head of School or the Graduate Co-ordinator of the School, and
- the second referee should be one of the above or the applicant's prospective supervisor if he/she has sufficient knowledge of the applicant.

Applicants from other institutions should choose appropriate referees. If possible applicants should follow similar principles to those detailed above in nominating referees from their own institutions who have informed, personal and professional knowledge of their academic ability and who may exercise judgement of their research potential.

ADVICE TO REFEREES

All applicants for graduate research scholarships are required to nominate two referees. You are requested to complete the Referee Report form from the web address listed at the top of this page and forward it directly and as soon as possible after receipt to: **The Graduate Research and Scholarships Office, The University of Western Australia** (see full address below). The candidate's success may depend on your report.

Applicants' Honours results and undergraduate academic records, together with their School and Referees' assessments, will be taken into account by the Scholarships Selection Committee to achieve a final ranking of applicants. The University is particularly interested in your opinion of the applicant's research ability. Please apply your present knowledge of the current applicant in relation to all Honours level candidates you have known in your capacity as a supervisor of postgraduate or Honours students and your own appreciation of Honours standards.
