

Step by Step Guide in applying for the UWA Winthrop Leaders and UWA Fogarty Foundation Scholarship

Step 1: Registration

- Register as a new user (future student) through our application portal 'Pandora' <https://pandora.grs.uwa.edu.au>

Complete all relevant information

Important points:

- Applicant will need to answer 'yes' to the commencing tertiary study question to be eligible.
- Refrain from using your high school email as you will not have access to your school email after completion of high school and you may miss out on important notifications.
- Remember your registration details as you may want to return to the application portal at a later date. If you do return to the portal, select 'Returning User' and fill in your username and password which you would have created when you initially registered.

Step 2: Application

Section 1

Tick the box on the scholarship/s you are applying for.

Important point:

- You only submit one application to be considered for both scholarships.

What this means is you will be assessed for both scholarships and shortlisted accordingly for the next stage of the scholarship process which is interview stage.

Section 2

Select the relevant information and provide documentation where required.

Section 3

Achievements/Personal Statements

There are five categories with a new bonus category 'Initiatives'. You will need to demonstrate excellence in at least three of the five categories and the bonus category if you can support this for bonus points, you will submit a synopsis of your activity/achievements for your initiatives.

The categories are as follows:

1. Academic,
2. Arts,
3. Community Contribution,
4. Leadership or
5. Sport

Each category has five levels of assessments:

- Selection for or achievement at intra-school or one-off events
- Selection for or achievement at school or local community level
- Selection for or achievement at regional or district level
- Selection for or achievement at state level
- Selection for or achievement at national level

Note: You may add up to 4 new achievements per category which may outline different level of assessment. You will not receive additional points for entering the same achievement in two or more categories e.g. school choir captain under arts and leadership.

Process

1. Type in the achievement
2. Select your category name from the drop down menu
3. Select achievement year from the drop down menu
4. Type in the achievement title
5. *Participation level of achievement* – **LEAVE BLANK** (the assessor will add a point level accordingly)
6. Type in the description of documentary evidence (please supply)
7. Type in the description of achievement/personal statement
8. Upload documentary evidence of achievement/personal statement documents
9. If applicable upload 300 word synopsis of your 'Initiative' if you wish to be assessed accordingly for bonus points

Repeat the same process for each category you are applying under.

Section 4

Submit your Application

Print out the Scholarship Application Confirmation form, sign and scan it back to Coursework Scholarships & Prizes office at uwafogarty@uwa.edu.au

Step 3: Requirement for the 'bonus' category:

'Initiatives' is a bonus area of assessment.

In order to submit a bonus category for assessment you will need to action the following:

- You will need to submit a short (maximum 300 words) synopsis of an initiative you have developed or in which you have significantly contributed.
- Been a significant contributor of the initiative.
 - Initiatives include creating a program, product or Service; – to trying to solve a problem or is of benefit to others. For example; starting a small business, developing an app, and creating a volunteering program, running an event or building a network of people.

Refer to the [MATRIX](#) as a guide. **Guiding**

questions for the submission:

1. What is the initiative?
2. What was the motivation for creating or being involved in the initiative?
3. Does the initiative generate income or is there a social dividend?
4. What support, funding, skills development or mentoring have you received from others?

Step 4: Assessment Process:

All applications go through a rigorous process.

- Eligible applications are assessed through a selection panel.
- Each applicant is allocated points to the category in which they have applied for.
- Applicants with the highest overall points will be shortlisted for the next stage of the selection process which is the Interview stage.

What is next?

After you have participated in the interview process the panel will make their final assessment and selection. The panel will select the 10 UWA Winthrop Leaders and 10 UWA Fogarty Foundation Scholarship awardees accordingly.

The results of the scholarship being awarded will only be made public as soon as the final ATAR results are released. Each candidate will receive a personal phone call advising on their outcome.
